A large part of the tutorial is dedicated to the discussion of your research projects in small groups – each supervised by an experienced senior researcher (after your 15 minutes presentation, you will have another 15 minutes for feedback). The aim is for you to briefly outline your research and from that engage in an intensive interactive sessions aiming at giving you advice and feedback for the particular questions you have.
